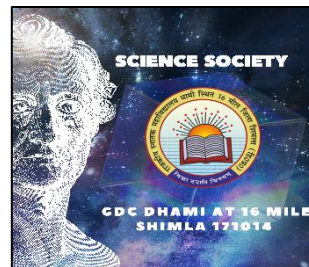




Report: Visit to CSCL Science Museum, Shogi, Shimla
