### ABOUT COLLEGE



Government College Dhama at 16 Mile is the only institute of tertiary education in the region providing fruits of higher education to the youth of the area. This College was announced in January 2016 by the then Chief Minister of Himachal Pradesh, Late Sh. Virbhadra Singh. The official notification was issued in February 2016 vide letter no. EDN-A- Ka (1)-2/2012-L-Pt, Dated 15th February 2016. The College is affiliated to Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla. It is named after a place called 'Dhama' which is of historical importance. Dhama was a Princely State founded by the descendants of Prithvi Raj Chauhan in the thirteenth century. It is situated 16 miles west of Shimla and became a constituent

of Himachal Pradesh in 1948.

The *Dhama Prajamandal Movement* played a significant role in the independence of India, the famous *Dhama Goli Kand* being a watershed event thereof, which was taken note of by Mahatma Gandhi himself. The famous festival of stones, *Patharon-Ka-Mela*, held after Diwali is still a unique feature of Dhama's cultural life. It is a beautiful drive from Shimla towards Mandi till *Solah-Meel-Ka-Mod*, from where the roads divert uphill to the College campus. Its sheer isolation from the mainstream hum-drum, 270-degree view of the Shimla hills, history, and folklore -- all combine to make it an ideal location for the teaching-learning process.

The College has adequate infrastructure and academic facilities including a library, multipurpose hall, conference room, virtual classroom, science laboratories, a small but fully functional IT Lab and well-lit classrooms. We, at the College, believe in providing to our students an environment conducive to acquire knowledge and basic life skills through a host of co-curricular and extracurricular activities. The College encourages a quest for knowledge that is rooted in an ethical understanding of the world. This enthusiasm for learning along with a desire to evolve into socially responsible human-beings is visible through their participation



or involvement in the programs of local, national, and international interests. The efficient, experienced, and enthusiastic faculty of the institution not only believes in attributing the best of academic expertise to the students in the courses of their study, but also tries to impart value education in its true sense. This will lead to the enlargement of intellectual and humanitarian tendencies of the students and prepare them to meet the larger world outside the College campus.

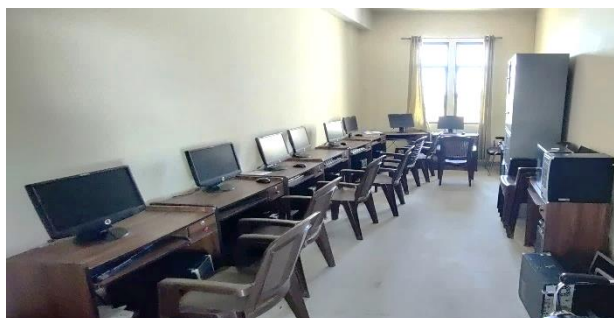
## LEARNING INFRASTRUCTURE

College has a four story building comprising an Administrative Block, six lecture theatres, four class rooms, one library, one lab each for, Geography, Chemistry, Physics, Zoology and Botany, separate Music Room for Instrumental and Vocal music, one Multipurpose Hall, Girls common room, ICT lab, one room each for NCC, NSS, Physical Education, Rovers and Rangers, one canteen, a general gathering room, two stores, electric and server room, Pantry, steno room, record room, examination room, reception cum fee counter and a bank extension.

Each floor has separate toilets for girls and boys. First floor of the building has ramp facility for differently abled students.

## LIBRARY

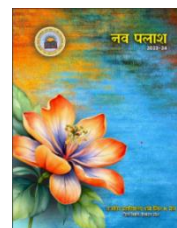

## EVENTS & ACTIVITIES

An Induction meeting was convened for the students of B.A. B.Sc. & B.Com first year students on 07-08- 2024. Principal Dr Janesh Kapoor briefed the students regarding the UGC-CBCS system. The broad outlines of the courses and the credit schemes were explained in a simplified manner. The students were introduced to the various faculty members, the co-curricular activities, institutional policies, processes and value systems. All guidelines regarding discipline, time table and membership to the various clubs and societies were explained in detail.



- On 4-8-2024, students from our College participated in Dr Y.S Parmar Birth Centenary celebration at Gaiety Theatre, Shimla. - In order to promote green initiatives, a plantation drive was organised on 7-8-2024 in area adjacent to the College campus. The drive was led by the volunteers of NSS and Rovers & Rangers. The drive was coordinated jointly by Contractors Association, Dhami, PWD and our units of NSS & Rovers & Rangers. About 30 saplings of Deodar and Oak were planted by the volunteers.
- Eight students of the college participated in Himachal Pradesh University Inter College Group I (Creativity) Youth Festival held at Bilaspur from 14- 16 October 2024. They participated in Elocution, Debate, Quiz Competition, Clay- Modelling, Cartooning and Poster Making.

- On 30 August 2024, a lecture on “Power Information Management” was organized by Commerce Society in collaboration with NSS Units of GDC Dhami at 16 Mile. The lecture was delivered by Mr. Anurag Prashar, Additional Director HPSEB, H.P. He provided valuable information regarding energy conservation, life skills, safety tips in the event of short circuit, lightning and thunderstorms. Mr. Prashar interacted with the students, solved their queries and shared his phone number for any further questions.



- Under the aegis of Language and Culture department Himachal Pradesh, State level “Hindi Diwas’ was celebrated with great enthusiasm throughout the State. A series of intercollege competitions ranging from Elocution, Poetry Recitation, Debate and Quiz were organised at Gaiety Theatre from 14-9-2024 & 15-9-2024. Anushka Sharma of B.A 2<sup>nd</sup> year brought laurels to the institution by bagging first prize in elocution.

- Thirteen students from the Music Department participated in Himachal Pradesh Group II Youth Festival held at Government College Karsog w.e.f. 22-10-2024 to 27-10-2024. Anjali, Kirti, Mamta, Ashmita Pal, Mamta Kaul, Poonam, Diksha, Kapil Kapoor, Yachna, Bharti Bhupender and Tarun participated in the various musical items. We are happy to announce that Kapil Kapoor bagged II prize in Non-Percussion Instrumental Music.



- Constitution Day was observed on 26-11-2024 by the staff members and the students of the college in the Library Hall at 11.00 A.M. The celebration began with the Pledge to the Preamble of the Indian Constitution. Prof. Manila Gupta, Assistant Prof., Political Science, threw light on the Constitutional history of India and the relevance of the vision of the founding fathers of the Indian Constitution for resolving the crisis prevailing in today’s context. Students presented their views regarding Secularism and its challenges.



The concept of Socialism and the changes in the wake of Liberalisation, Globalisation and Privatisation was presented by Khushboo of B.A II. Two power point presentations were presented on topics of ‘Democracy and its Challenges’ by Ashmita Pal of B.A III year and on ‘Women Members of the Constituent Assembly and their Role’ by Kartikey of B.A II year.

## OUR BEST PRACTICES

We at GDC Dhami are committed towards our best practices. In the session 2024-25 some activities towards capacity building & Academic and Cultural leadership were organized through active collaboration of NSS and the various subject societies:

- A lecture on “Communication Skills” was delivered by Prof Praveen Malik( Retd. Principal & Professor of English) on 6-11-2024. About 70 students attended the lecture in the Library Hall. He touched upon the various aspects of communication and elaborated the importance of communication skills.



The speaker emphasized the importance of vocabulary and the importance of learning the same. He also touched upon verbal & non-verbal communication, Artificial Intelligence, and machine learning. He interacted with the students and addressed their queries.

- During the session 2024-25 one-month((30-hour) Computer Essentials Course was successfully coordinated by Dr Naveen Thakur from 1-12-2024 to 31-12-2024. About 22 students enhanced their skills by learning Microsoft Office Suite(Word, Excel &Power Point), Email Basics, Computer and Internet Security and Privacy.



- To face the emerging need of numerical skills and demanding competitions, the students need to be well equipped with the numerical abilities. A special lecture series on “Reasoning and Numerical Ability” was conducted for the students of second & final years by Dr Geeta. This programme was conducted in three sessions of two hours each. First Lecture on ‘Number Series’ was conducted on 16-11-2024. On dated 28-11-2024 & 14-12-2024, Lectures on ‘Matrices’ and ‘Alphabet Analogy’ respectively were held. Students actively participated in these lectures.

- Our institution takes pride in our best practice of Liaisoning with schools. Our NSS volunteers and In charges devoted ample time for organising activities in our adopted schools during the session 2024-25. The Volunteers celebrated Children’s’ Day with the students of Primary School Ghandal, and observed Constitution day on 26-11-2024

- A lecture on “Exploring Career Options for Students” was delivered by Dr Naveen Thakur on dated 21-12-2024 so as to inspire students to pursue science as a career, he motivated students to opt for the science stream in their higher studies. Some basic experiments like interference, gravity, role of air pressure and inertial frame were demonstrated to the students. A practical demonstration of scientific concepts were demonstrated in a simplified manner.



- The volunteers of NSS performed “NUKKAD NATAK” on Drug abuse in the first week of December.



- In a benevolent gesture towards social responsibility, Our Principal contributed a sum of Rs 50,000/( Rupees fifty thousand only) to our adopted school Government Senior secondary school Dhami towards Library upgradation on dated 6-12-2024
- The girls from GDC Dhami presented the local folk *Badhuan* at Principal’s conference held on 30-11-2024 -01-12-2024 at Patterhoff, Shimla. The performance was highly appreciated by Hon’ble Education Minister and officials from the deptt of Higher Education.

- We house an Archive Section which provides with the facts, evidences, reports, photographs and antique articles.

Students are time and again provided an opportunity to visit The Himachal Pradesh State Museum for gaining practical learning and understanding regarding the preservation of Artefacts, Manuscripts and the rare artifacts.

- A special programme “समागम 2024” was organized on 13-12-2024 for the volunteers of GDC Dhami. About 70 volunteers of NSS, Rovers & Rangers, CSCA and some active students were felicitated by Dr Janesh Kapoor for their participation and their services throughout the year in various activities. 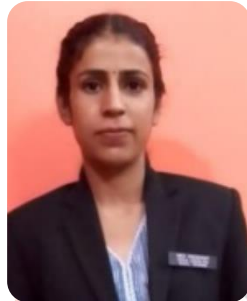


## PARENT TEACHER ASSOCIATION (PTA)

## STUDENT CENTRIC ACTIVITIES

### NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS)

We have two NSS units actively working in our institution.

- On dated 7th August 2024, Mega Plantation Drive was organized by Contractor Association of Dhama Division Shimla. In this drive a team of 35 volunteers of NSS visited the adjacent forest site of GDC Dhama at 16 Mile, where they planted 40 Oak trees in collaboration with Rover and Rangers as well as Contractor Association of Dhama Division Shimla. The plantation was carried out with the collective efforts of Forest guard, NSS volunteers and faculty members of the college.



- On 9th September 2024, an Induction Programme was organised for the newly enrolled NSS volunteers. Detailed information regarding NSS scheme, activities and its functioning was shared with the newly enrolled 20 NSS Volunteers. The NSS in charges encouraged and motivated the students towards community service.



- In the beginning of “Swachhta Pakhwada”, i.e. on 14th September 2024, NSS units of GDC Dhama organized cleanliness drive under the leadership of Prof. Dinesh Sharma (Programme Officer). In this drive, 55 NSS volunteers participated. They collected garbage and plastic from college campus and surroundings.



On 30-11-2024 the volunteers undertook a Cleanliness Drive in our adopted Primary school at Ghandal. The main objective of this drive was to spread awareness amongst students regarding the importance of environment by making plastic free campus and surroundings. The volunteers also took the pledge “Swachhta hi Seva”

- Six volunteers of our College attended one day selection camp at GDC Kotshera. NSS volunteer Munish Kumar was selected for Distt level PRE RD camp held at Sunder Nagar.

He participated in NSS Pre Republic Day Parade camp 2024 organised by the NSS Regional Directorate, Jaipur at Vivekananda Global University



Jaipur from 14th October to 23rd October 2024.

- A team of 11 NSS Volunteers undertook a post plantation care drive at *KALANI DHAR* on 24-10-2024. The volunteers took stock of the last plantation drive held in July 2023. The heavy forest fire took toll of the saplings, only 23 Oak plants could be found. Volunteers mapped each plant, removed weeds and grass grown over and around them.



- On 8-11-2024 Cleanliness Drive towards Campus Beautification was undertaken by the NSS Volunteers. *NSS Vatika* was also cleaned by uprooting the dried saplings, weeds and other unwanted stuff.

- On World AIDS Day NSS Units of GDC Dhami observed “World AIDS Day” on 2-12-2024. “*A Nukkad Natak*” depicting the Prevention and redressal of AIDS was enacted by the volunteers.

- On the eve of Independence Day on 14-8-2024 N.S.S unit of Govt. College Dhami at 16 Mile organised plethora of events under the program 'Har Ghar Tiranga'. These include a talk on 'Freedom Struggle and Making of Modern India' by Dr. Kishori Chandel. A talk on 'Flag Code and Values Enshrined in Constitution of India' by Ms. Namita, Patriotic songs by Volunteers, Pledge to Honour the Tiranga and Tiranga Rally by 89 Volunteers and Teaching and Non -Teaching Staff.

- Foundation Day of NSS: On dated 24-9-2029 NSS foundation day was observed and celebrated in a novel way. The Sociological Society, GDC Dhami and the NSS Unit organised a “Traditional Food Festival”. Almost 96 Volunteers and other students displayed traditional



food items prepared by them. The students in their traditional attires displayed stalls of local crops as well as traditional foods. Crops like *Kodara, Jowar, Makki, Kulath, Bajra* as well as spices were displayed. The Volunteers also served traditional dishes like *Ankloo, Saag, Siddu, Poldu, Cholai ki kheer, Amla Dish, Dahin-Bare, Makki ka Metha*. Two presentations by Anoushka and Kushboo threw light on the Role of Millets in healthy living and the importance of Organic farming in sustaining local economy respectively.

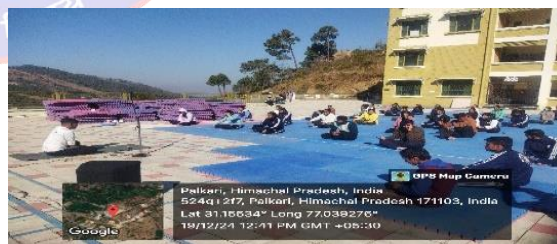
