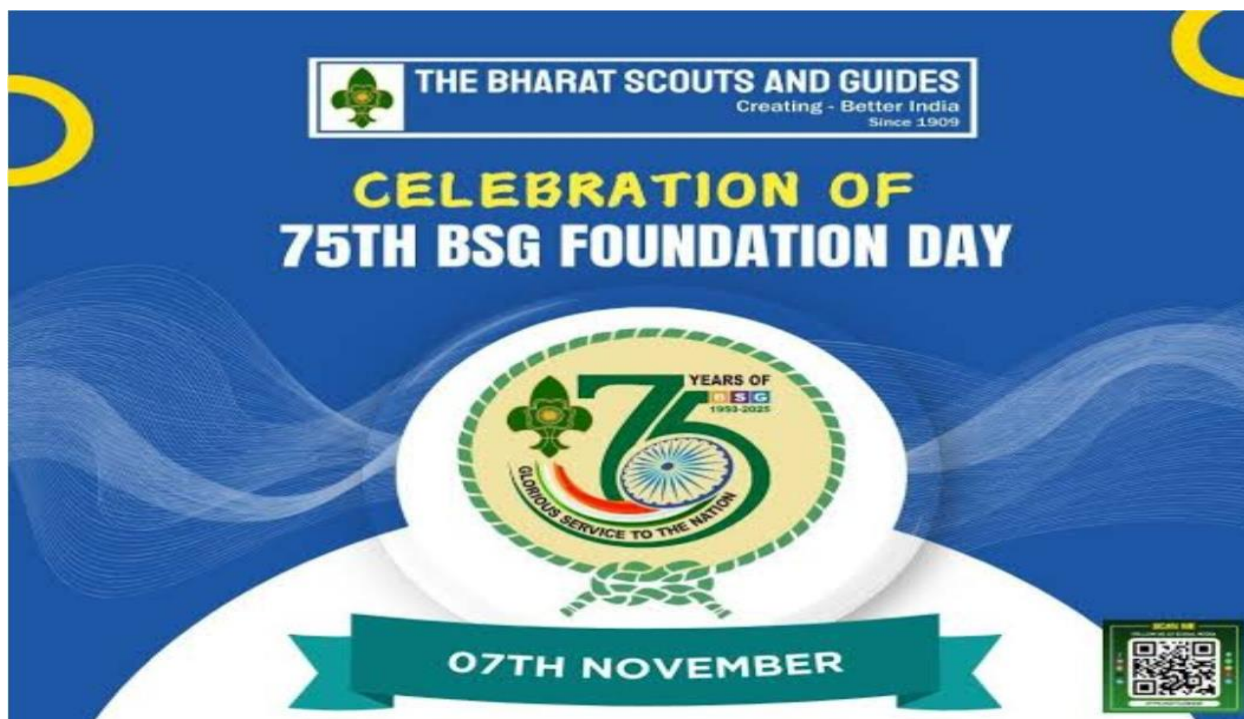

Rovers and Rangers Foundation / BSG Flag Day Celebration

The Rovers and Rangers Foundation / Bharat Scouts and Guides (BSG) Flag Day was observed with great enthusiasm and reverence in the College Auditorium on 7th November, 2025.
