The National Service Scheme (NSS) at G. D. C. Dhami at 16 Mile is a flourishing body of dedicated student volunteers and teachers who are devoted to the cause of bringing about positive social change and truly making a difference. Selflessness and commitment resonate through the slogan 'Not Me, But You' in all its initiatives. The vision and collective potential of the students is realized through grass-root level work with multiple on-ground community service endeavors. As a group, NSS also opens up space for dialogue and deliberation over a range of pertinent issues.

1. **Celebration of International Yoga Day:** On 21st June 2023, International Yoga Day was observed in the college by the NSS volunteers and Dr Ramlal Bhardwaj (Programme officer of NSS). Yoga trainer, Sh. Satish Bhardwaj and PTA president Smt. Sushila Verma made the students aware regarding various Yoga exercises and healthy lifestyle. More than 50 NSS volunteers actively participated in the program.



2. **Mega Plantation Drive:** On 26th July 2023, Mega Plantation Drive was organized by NSS units. This program was organized in context with 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav'. The plantation was carried out in the adopted forest at Kalani Dhar with the collective efforts of Forest guard, 150 NSS volunteers and faculty members of the college.



3. **National Sports Day:** On 29th August 2023, National sports day was observed by NSS units in collaboration with department of Physical Education. More than 50 NSS volunteers and other college students participated in sports activities like kho kho, kabbadi, badminton etc.



4. **On 5th September 2023, Teachers' day** was celebrated by the NSS units. Campus beautification and environment protection through plantation activities were carried out by 86 Volunteers.



5. **On 26th September 2023,** the NSS units organized cleanliness awareness campaign. The volunteers made the students aware of the single use plastic and its effects on environment. Awareness rally was also organized from college to 16 Mile chock for making the people of the area aware regarding their health. 120 volunteers participated in the event.



6. **NSS Foundation Day Celebration:** On 6th October 2024, NSS units organised NSS Foundation Day. Many cultural activities were carried out like solo songs, group songs, solo dance, Nati, etc. Principal of the college, Dr Janesh Kapoor was the chief guest for the program. 150 volunteers made the event successful with their active participation.



7. **Amrit Kalash Yatra:** After celebrating NSS founder day NSS units of the college organized “Amarit Kalash Yatra” on 6th October 2023, in college premises under the directions of Central Youth services and ministry of sports. The Program was inaugurated by the Principal of the college.



8. **Pre-Republic Day Parade Camp:** Pre – Republic Day Parade Camp was organized at Manohar Memorial College Fatehabad Hararyana w.e.f. 25-10-2023 to 03-11-2023. Miss Asmita Pal, NSS volunteer of our college participated in this camp. She was selected for this Parade Camp on 11th October 2023 in state level selection camp organized by GDC Bilaspur, Himachal Pradesh.



9. **Khadi Mohotsav Celebration:** NSS units celebrated Khadi Mohotsav on 31st October 2023 in virtual class room of the college. Mr. Dinesh Sharma (Programme officer of NSS) elaborated the importance of khadi in detail. On this occasion declaration and poster making competitions were organized for awareness. Ms. Geeta (Programme officer) encouraged and motivated the volunteers for their enthusiastic participation. 65 volunteers participated in the celebration.



10. **Cleanliness Drive:** On 8th November 2023, NSS organised a cleanliness drive for college beautification in which volunteers took care of the plants of college campus and NSS Vatika under the guidance of programme officers Sh. Dinesh Sharma and Ms. Geeta. 72 volunteers took part in the drive.



11. **Celebration of Constitution Day:** NSS volunteers celebrated “Constitution Day” in collaboration with Rover and Rangers and department of Political Science on 25th November, 2023. 12. World AIDS DAY: On 30th November 2023, NSS Volunteers organized plethora of activities to commemorate World AIDS DAY. Declaration, Poster making, slogan writing and collage making contests were carried out. Red Ribbon Club collaborated to observe the day. All college students were involved to spread the awareness.



13. One Day Camp for After- Care of Planted trees: On 5th December 2023, under the guidance of Miss Geeta, a team of 15 volunteers of NSS visited the adopted forest site where volunteers had planted 60 Oak trees in the month of July 2023. Volunteers mapped each plant, removed weeds and grass grown over and around them.



14. Participation in State Level Mega Camp: Four NSS volunteers Nishant Verma, Anjali, Priyanka and Aryan had participated in State level Mega camp of NSS held G.D.C. Banjar, Kullu Himachal Pradesh w.e.f. 18-12-2023 to 22-12-2023. In this camp, volunteers were guided and trained for national service through community work.
